Crash repair specialists Car Cosmetics Ltd, based in Waterlooville, are delighted with the results of their new spraybooth installation by Sudbury-based Spraybooth Technology Limited (STL).

The installation includes two new extended-length Cyclone II spraybooths, sized to accommodate hi-top vans, with STL's unique air-cooled lighting system, fully gridded floors, full roof filtration and high-efficiency air handling plant providing laminar airflows of 33,000m³/hr. The perfect clean-air environment for painting of vehicles.



And what has most impressed Ian Berry, Director of Car Cosmetics? "I can't believe how quiet the new booths are! You can hold a conversation, without raising your voice, while standing right next to the booth running at full load." Conscious of the importance of Health and Safety in the workplace, Ian feels that comfortable working noise levels are increasingly important.

Car Cosmetics was established in 1981 and is renown for high quality workmanship and a friendly, professional service. The new installation, part of an expansion into a new 11,000ft² premises, is not Ian's first experience of working with STL, as Ian bought his first Cyclone II in 2002 when Car Cosmetics first moved to the Hazelton Interchange, Horndean, to cope with growing demand.

"Although we were very happy with the existing Cyclone II, and the performance, service and back up offered by STL, we didn't close the door to anyone," explains Ian. "We spoke to a number of well-know spraybooth suppliers, but only STL met the criteria for this Land Rover-approved bodyshop, in terms of specification and cost."

Key to STL's success is the operating efficiency of the spraybooths. "In the end it was a very simple decision," says Ian, "STL booths still out perform anyone else's, and they were the only supplier who did not require me to meet the considerable expense of installing a larger gas meter to run their plant!"
