

Project Title: New spraying facility for Marshall Vehicle Engineering, Mildenhall

Date and duration: Four-month program completed in April 2007

Nature of work: Supply two-off production line spraybooths, two-off undercoat spraybooths and one-off combi-booth for their new facility at Mildenhall dedicated to the production and fitting of vehicle bodies for the MOD. The installation included a manual overhead conveyor system with integrated "drop down" section to facilitate easy loading and unloading of products. The production line Spraybooths are fitted with STL's unique AquaDry System, which has dramatically reduced flash off and bake times. The plant was installed as part of the £1bn deal done by MAN & the MoD in 2005. The contract was the biggest truck deal in Europe for 25 years and involves Marshall SV's cargo bodies, EKA's recovery equipment, Andover's recovery trailers and tanker and fuel dispensing kit from Fluid Transfer. This was a textbook project, installed to the client's complete satisfaction.
