

SCOT GROUP T/A THRIFTY CAR & VAN RENTAL

- Location:* Nuneaton Vehicle Refurbishment Centre
- Application:* De-fleet and body repairs to Scot Hire and Thrifty rental fleet for both cars and vans
- Reason for installation:* Existing side-loading spraybooth and oven facilities were causing a bottle neck in productivity due to increased workloads
- STL equipment installed:* Four off STL Cyclone II drive-through spraybooths complete with AquaDry air agitation, Eco Pack, Variable Speed Drives and roof-mounted air handling plant.
- Project overview:* Scot Group discussed the project with a number of the UK's leading suppliers, yet it was STL who demonstrated the attention to detail and commitment to meet the objectives of the project in as cost effectively as possible.
- On STL's advice, Scot Group decided to move away from side-loading systems (and the associated risk of paint contamination), recognising that faster drying paints, combined with high airflow spraybooths fitted with AquaDry air agitation, mean that combi booths offered the best productivity per square foot of floor space.
- STL undertook a complete workflow analysis and bodyshop layout design, and demonstrated the improvements to workflow that could be achieved with drive-through spraybooths.
